

	Citations per Paper	This ratio measures the average number of citations obtained per publication, and is a proxy of the impact and quality of the scientific work done by universities. Underlying data of papers and citations is indexed by Scopus. The paper and citation counts are normalized in an attempt to equalize their influence across the five broad faculty areas.	5.0%
	Papers per Faculty	This indicator seeks to determine the average number of scientific publications (papers) produced per faculty and evaluates the productivity of research institutions. Data is extracted from Scopus. Indexed papers over a period of five years are used. The paper count is normalized, ensuring that papers published in each of the five broad faculty areas are weighted equally.	5.0%

Collaborative research has benefits not only in terms of overall research quality and transparency, but in helping to solve global problems across borders. 



Percentage of institutions surpassed in terms of rank






Overall Score **5.0**



We did not apply our standard and full normalisation procedures to the scores. This year we have reconciled the normalisation in line with our other indicators. 

Observations:


Research OutputPapers and Citations by Subject Area




The following graphs provide the institution's breakdown of papers and citations by broad subject area indexed by Scopus and used in the 2024 edition of the rankings. Starting from the previous edition, QS considers six years of citations (2017-2022) for each of the five publication years (2017-2021).

The regional rankings methodology employs the Citations per Paper and Paper per Faculty indicators and, thus, this approach seeks to derive normalised total citation and paper counts. The objective of this process is to equalise the influence of the five broad subject areas considered.
